The Latter Times

Philippians 3:18-19

18(For many walk, of whom I have told you often, and now tell you even weeping, *that they are* the enemies of the cross of Christ: 19Whose end *is* destruction, whose God *is their* belly, and *whose* glory *is* in their shame, who mind earthly things.)

"Worship is no longer worship when it reflects the culture around us more than the Christ within us." - A.W. Tozer

Perilous Times shall indeed come and are even now here. As the Lord Jesus gets ready to close this age of human history – 'the time of the gentiles, the church age, the age of grace' there will be many deceivers given to the workings of Satan to mislead the people and corrupt the church through false teachings. Also Christian shall rise against Christian . Not all will be as it appears; there will be enemies of the cross both without and within the church.

False Prophets and Doctrines of Devils (Demons)

Matthew 7:15-17, 21-23

15Beware of false prophets, which come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravening wolves.16Ye shall know them by their fruits. Do men gather grapes of thorns, or figs of thistles?17Even so every good tree bringeth forth good fruit; but a corrupt tree bringeth forth evil fruit.

21Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven.

22Many will say to me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in thy name? and in thy name have cast out devils? and in thy name done many wonderful works?23And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity.

"My feelings as a Christian points me to my Lord and Savior as a fighter. As a Christian I have no duty to allow myself to be cheated, but I have the duty to be a fighter for truth and justice... And if there is anything which could demonstrate that we are acting rightly it is the distress that daily grows. We are a people of different faiths, but we are one. Which faith conquers the other is not the question; rather, the question is whether Christianity stands or falls.... We tolerate no one in our ranks who attacks the ideas of Christianity... in fact our movement is Christian. We were convinced that the people needs and requires this faith. We have therefore undertaken the fight against the atheistic movement, and that not merely with a few theoretical declarations: we have stamped it out. - *Adolf Hitler, in a speech in Berlin on 24 Oct. 1933*

This Winter Help Work is also in the deepest sense a Christian work. When I see, as I so often do, poorly clad girls collecting with such infinite patience in order to care for those who are suffering from the cold while they themselves are shivering with cold, then I have the feeling that they are all apostles of a Christianity-- and in truth of a Christianity which can say with greater right than any other: This is the Christianity of an honest confession, for behind it stand not words but deeds. - *Adolf Hitler, speaking of the Winter Help Campaign on 5 Oct. 1937*

If positive Christianity means love of one's neighbour, i.e. the tending of the sick, the clothing of the poor, the feeding of the hungry, the giving of drink to those who are thirsty, then it is we who are the more positive Christians. -*Adolf Hitler, in his speech to the "Old Guard" at Munich on 24 Feb. 1939*

(As seen above not everyone that claims Christianity and, call upon the name of the Lord is of the Lord.)

1Timothy 4:1

1Now the Spirit speaketh expressly, that in the latter times some shall depart from the faith, giving heed to seducing spirits, and <u>doctrines of devils</u>;

doctrines = didaskalia - did-as-kal-ee'-ah

From G1320; instruction (the function or the information): - doctrine, learning, teaching.

Daimonion - dahee-mon'-ee-on Neuter of a derivative of G1142; a daemonic being; by extension a deity: - devil, god.

The Spirit of the Age

2Timothy 3:1-5, 7-8, 12-13

1This know also, that in the last days perilous times shall come.

2For men shall be lovers of their own selves, covetous, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy,

3Without natural affection, trucebreakers, false accusers, incontinent, fierce, despisers of those that are good,

4Traitors, heady, highminded, lovers of pleasures more than lovers of God;

5Having a form of godliness, but denying the power thereof: from such turn away.

7Ever learning, and never able to come to the knowledge of the truth. 8Now as Jannes and Jambres withstood Moses, so do these also resist the truth: men of corrupt minds, reprobate concerning the faith.

Warning to the False Church

Galatians 1:6-12

6I marvel that ye are so soon removed from him that called you into the grace of Christ unto another gospel:

7Which is not another; but there be some that trouble you, and would pervert the gospel of Christ. 8But though we, or an angel from heaven, preach any other gospel unto you than that which we have preached unto you, let him be accursed.

9As we said before, so say I now again, If any *man* preach any other gospel unto you than that ye have received, let him be accursed.

10For do I now persuade men, or God? or do I seek to please men? for if I yet pleased men, I should not be the servant of Christ.

11But I certify you, brethren, that the gospel which was preached of me is not after man.

12For I neither received it of man, neither was I taught *it*, but by the revelation of Jesus Christ.

I Peter 4:17

17For the time *is come* that judgment must begin at the house of God: and if *it* first *begin* at us, what shall the end *be* of them that obey not the gospel of God?

God's judgment on the world, and condemnation with it; see <u>1Co 11:32</u> and these may be said to "begin" with them, because it is only in this life the saints have their afflictions; and which are in love to them, and therefore are early brought upon them to try them, and purge them, and make them partakers of his holiness: -*Gill*
